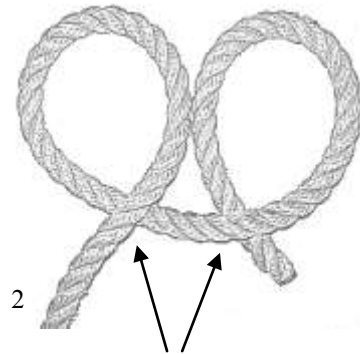
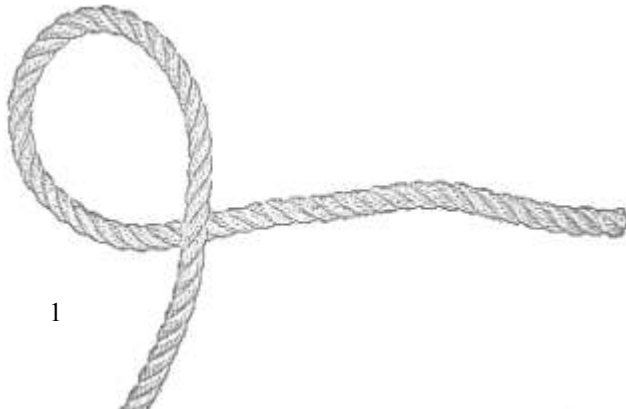


Clove Hitch – Grannies Glasses version

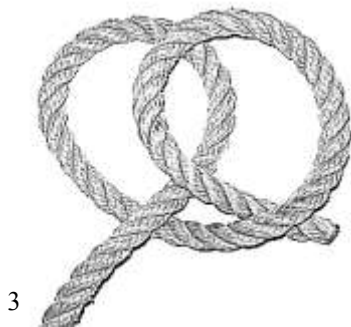
Uses:

This hitch is used to attach a rope to a spar or pole. It works best where the strain on the knot is pulling directly and at right angles away from the spar.

It is often used to start square and diagonal lashing as it holds the rope tight to the pole.



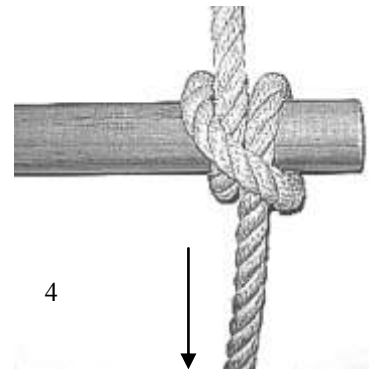
Note that the loops are different. One rope is in front of the loop and one behind.



Lift the right hand loop up and place it on top of the left hand loop.



Slide the loops over the pole and pull the ends to tighten the hitch.



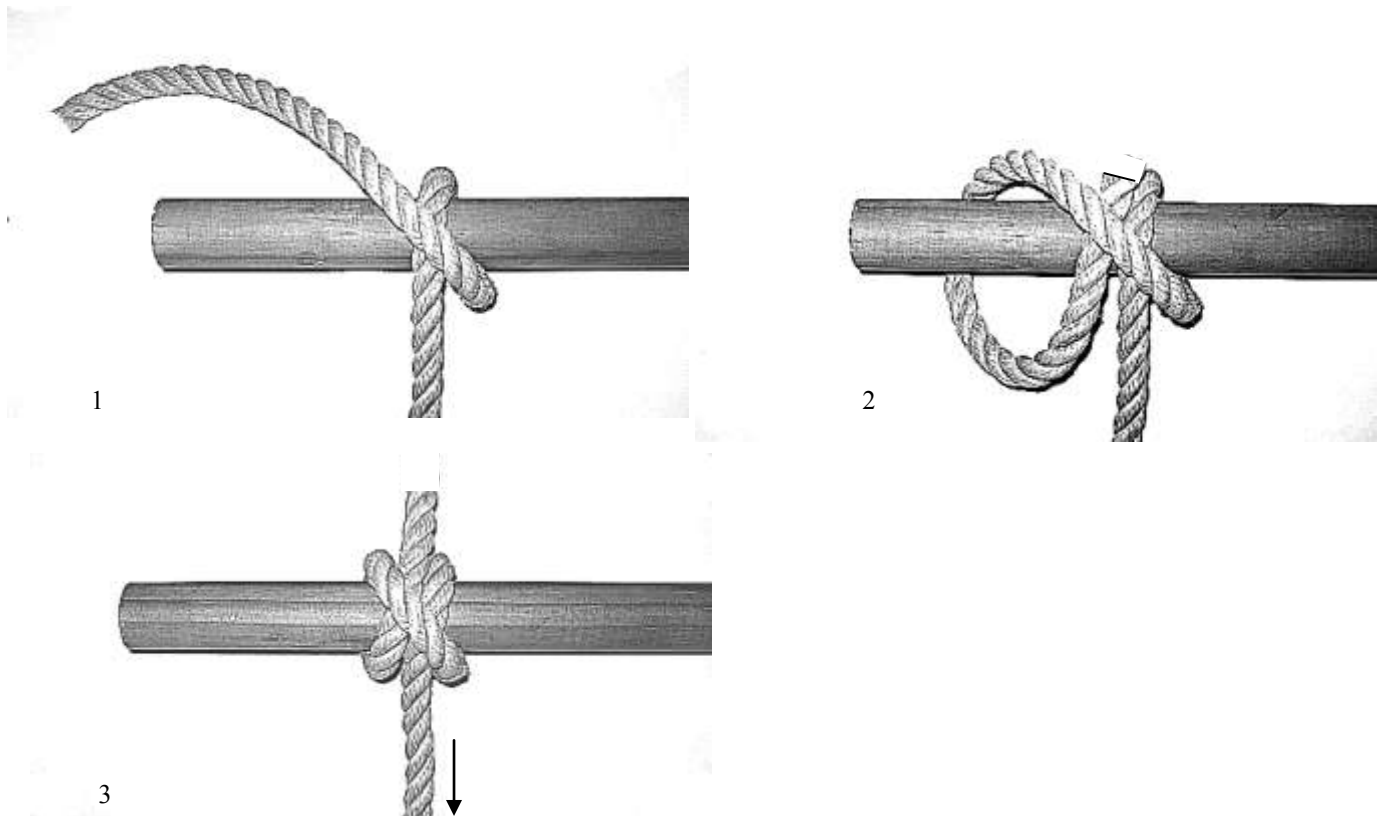
The strain on the rope must be at right angles to the pole to keep the hitch tight.

Clove Hitch

Uses:

This hitch is used to attach a rope to a spar or pole. It works best where the strain on the knot is pulling directly and at right angles away from the spar.

It is often used to start square and diagonal lashing and for rope ladders.



Note: The strain on the rope must always be at right angles to the hitch to keep it tight.
