What is a Gang Show?

In case you are wondering, a Gang Show is a 2 hour musical type review performed by Scouts, Guides, Venturers, Rangers, Rovers and some leaders.

The intent of a Gang Show is to provide a creative outlet for Scout and Guide youth who have an interest in music, dance and acting. Gang Shows originated in London in the 1930s and it popularly believed that there is a Gang Show performing somewhere in the world every night of each year.

In Auckland there are two Gang Shows, each performing every second year. They are the 'Central Gang Show' and the 'North Shore Gang Show', each with a cast of around 100 youth members. The Auckland Central Gang Show also has it own orchestra.
